Meet Our Clinicians

Jeff Ausdemore

Jeff Ausdemore serves as President and Co-Founder of Stryvemind.com, a revolutionary online music education platform that impacts students and educators around the world. Prior, Mr. Ausdemore was the Director of Music at Grapevine-Colleyville's iUniversity Prep, overseeing all music curricula, including music theory, music history, music composition/arranging, as well as applied music for all primary and secondary level students. In addition, Mr. Ausdemore created the iMusic Club, a club dedicated to enriching the lives of all students enrolled at iUniversity Prep.

Prior to this post, Mr. Ausdemore served eleven years as the Director of Percussion Studies at Colleyville Heritage High School. In this role, Mr. Ausdemore served as the percussion coordinator, head of jazz studies, and co-director/composer/arranger of the Colleyville Heritage marching band. The CHHS percussion program enjoyed national notoriety, including gold medals in the NTCA Indoor Circuit, PAS Marching Percussion titles, the PAS "Call for Tapes" winners, the PAS Small Ensemble Champions, as well as multiple Lone Star and Plano Drum Line marching percussion titles.

Prior to his appointment to CHHS, Mr. Ausdemore taught at the University of Texas Arlington as adjunct professor of percussion, serving as the percussion arranger/assistant director of the UTA Marching Band, teaching percussion pedagogy/techniques classes, assisting the UTA percussion ensemble, and maintaining a full private studio as well.

J.J. Pipitone

JJ Pipitone enjoyed a lengthy drum corp career, having marched with numerous corps in the up-state New York area and the Dutch Boy, from Ontario, Canada. After high school, he moved on to the Phantom Regiment and aged out at the Concord Blue Devils.

As an educator, JJ taught the World Champion Phantom Regiment, the Glassmen and the Crossmen. He earned his Bachelor Degree in Music Education from Morehead State University and his Masters Degree in Music Education from the University of North Texas.

JJ invested 20 years in music education as an assistant band director in the Grapevine ISD and the Lewisville ISD. As an adjudicator, he has been honored to be a part of Drum Corp International, Bands of America and currently serves as a judge for Winter Guard International. JJ is currently living in Flower Mound, TX enjoying a second career as a real estate investor, while continuing to judge music and percussion all over the world.

Lauren Teel

Lauren Teel is the Percussion Caption Head for the Troopers Drum & Bugle Corps, Adjunct Professor of Percussion for Texas A&M Commerce, Director of Percussion for Mililani High School on Oahu, a member of the Heartland Marimba Ensemble, and Front Ensemble Instructor for the University of North Texas Green Brigade.

Previous appointments include Interim Professor of Percussion for the University of Alabama and Adjunct Professor of Percussion for the University of North Alabama, University of Montevallo, and University of Alabama at Birmingham. Lauren previously served as the Front Ensemble Coordinator for the Scholastic World Class Finalist Center Grove High School Indoor Drum Line in Greenwood, IN. Lauren holds a M.M. from Indiana University and B.M. from the University of North Texas, both in percussion performance.

In 2012, Lauren had the privilege of traveling to Chennai, India to perform for an audience of over 75,000 people with Oscar winning composer, A. R. Rahman. Lauren also appeared in the 2013 blockbuster, The Hunger Games: Catching Fire, as a timpanist. Lauren was a member of the 2009 and 2010 DCI World Class Phantom Regiment Drum & Bugle Corps, which received the 2010 Fred Sanford Award for high percussion, and of the 2011 Santa Clara Vanguard Drum & Bugle Corps.

Lauren proudly endorses Innovative Percussion, Marimba One, Zildjian Cymbals and Remo Drum Heads.

Dr. Brian West

Dr. Brian A. West is a Professor of Music and the Coordinator of Percussion at Texas Christian University. Under his direction, the percussion program at TCU has received international recognition. The TCU Percussion Orchestra won the 2015, 2011, 2008 and 2005 Percussive Arts Society International Percussion Ensemble Competitions, and the TCU Drumline won the 2012 and 2006 PAS Marching Percussion Festivals. Dr. West has conducted and performed in Hawaii, Italy, Spain, England, France, Australia, and Taiwan. Within the Percussive Arts Society he currently serves on the Board of Advisors and is the Chair of the Percussion Ensemble Committee.

Dr. West is an active performer, clinician, composer/arranger, and adjudicator for a variety of percussive events. He is the Executive Producer of four CDs, is published by drop6 media, and works as a clinician and endorser for Yamaha, Innovative Percussion, Remo, Marimba One, and Sabian.

Kennan Wylie

Kennan Wylie has been the Director of Percussion Studies at Marcus High School in Flower Mound, TX for three decades. Under his direction, the Marcus group has received national acclaim both on and off the field, including ten national championship titles at the PASIC Marching Competition. Marcus H.S. also won the 1999, 2003, 2007, and 2011 P.A.S. "Call for Tapes". Additional performances include the 2006 Midwest Band and Orchestra International Clinic in Chicago, IL.

Mr. Wylie is an educational endorser for Yamaha, Zildjian cymbals, Innovative Percussion, and Evans drumheads.
