

SPECTATOR PARKING

There is no charge for spectator parking. Enter using Stadium DR or Pennington DR (Hoot Smith Drive is exclusively for band bus and truck entry). We encourage you to arrive early and allow time to get into the stadium. Overview map linked here.

GET TICKETS ONLINE - Tickets are mobile. All sales final. No refunds. No exchanges.

- Adults: \$10 (+ processing fee)
- Students PK-12: \$6 (+ processing fee)
- Children 3 and under: Free
- o If unable to purchase online see a contest official onsite.

PROHIBITED ITEMS (See full Pennington Field spectator guidelines)

Backpacks/oversize bags are not allowed inside Pennington Field. Only clear bags and small "clutch" bags are allowed.

Other prohibited items include outside food, drinks, coolers, glass containers, alcohol, all tobacco products, e-cigarettes, heaters, air-horns, balloons, baby powder, silly string, streamers, confetti or any item our staff considers a danger to others.

RE-ENTRY

A wristband handed out by our Officials will allow attendees to re-enter the stadium.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND RECORDING POLICIES

Still cameras are allowed into the stadium and may be used from stadium seating. Video recording is not permitted with the exception of your Drumline Video Designee (see your Director's Information packet).

FIRST AID

There will be a minimal First-Aid station available. Consult a contest Official.

FEEDING YOUR GROUP *

There are several restaurants within walking distance east of the stadium complex, across Central Drive. For those who are driving a variety of restaurants are located north of Highway 183, along the feeder road.

*No cooking with open flames is allowed anywhere around Pennington Field. You are free to distribute food items that do not require flame, gas, or charcoal grill. Central Park is a small city park at the southeast corner of the complex and a good location to feed your group. Please bag your trash and use the dumpsters at the far west of the Pennington Field complex.
