SPECTATOR PARKING

There is no charge for spectator parking. Enter using Stadium DR or Pennington DR (Hoot Smith Drive is exclusively for band bus and truck entry). We encourage you to arrive early and allow time to get into the stadium. [Overview map linked here](#).

SPECTATOR BACKPACKS AND LARGE PURSES ARE PROHIBITED IN THE STADIUM

No backpacks or large purses/bags are allowed in the stadium. Only clear bags and small purse/clutch bags are allowed. [See full Pennington Field spectator guidelines](#) for a list of what is permitted and not permitted.

RE-ENTRY

A wristband handed out by our Officials will allow ticket holders to re-enter the stadium.

STADIUM PHOTOGRAPHY AND RECORDING POLICIES

Still cameras are allowed into the stadium and may be used from stadium seating. Video recording is not permitted with the exception of your Drumline Video Designee (see your Director's Information packet).

PROGRAM, SOUVENIRS, AND CONCESSIONS

Posted QR codes link to the online program. Souvenirs are available near the stadium entrance. Concessions are available beneath the grandstands. Water and limited concessions will be available for purchase near the ultimate lot clinic area.

FIRST AID

There will be a minimal First-Aid station available near the stadium. Consult a contest Official.

FEEDING YOUR GROUP*

Several restaurants can be walked to, across Central Drive. North of Highway 183 there is a wider variety of restaurants.

*No cooking with open flame is allowed. You are free to distribute food that requires no flame, gas, or charcoal grill. Central Park, a small city park at the southeast corner of the complex, is a good location to feed your group. You may bag your trash and use the row of dumpsters at the far west side of the Pennington Field complex for disposal. For recyclable items bagged separately, use the dumpster designated for recycling.
